Re:	Immediate Rescission and Withdrawal of KREC Resolution Regarding the Use of
	"Realty" or "Real Estate" in Group and Team Names

On May 21, 2020, The Kentucky Real Estate Commission (the "Commission) passed a resolution providing that a team or group name that includes the phrases "realty" or "real estate" will constitute a violation of 201 KAR 11:105(4)(3)(a) and will be considered misleading in violation of 201 KAR 11:105(5)(2).

At its June 18, 2020 meeting, the Commission undertook discussion to reconsider the abovedescribed resolution. Upon motion and by a majority vote of the Commissioners, the Commission rescinded and withdrew the resolution, effective immediately. The Commission agreed it will address and adjudicate on a case-by-case basis complaints and disciplinary actions regarding whether the contents of team and group names violate provisions of KRS Chapter 324 and/or 201 KAR Chapter 11.
