



FAQ Clarification from the KREC Meeting 3/19/2020:

Q: Have deadlines for completion of the “old” requirements for completing the broker’s education been extended?

A: Yes.

Q: When must the broker’s license requirements now be completed?

A: The Commission has extended the deadlines until the State of Emergency is concluded, plus forty-five (45) days. So, for example, if the State of Emergency is lifted on June 1, the new deadline will be July 15.

Q: Has the Commission impacted other deadlines?

A: Yes. All post-license education deadlines have been extended until the State of Emergency is concluded, plus thirty (30) days.

Q: Do I still need to renew my license by March 31?

A: Yes. You need to fulfill all requirements to renew your license that do not require you to make person to person contact. For instance, you need to provide evidence of your Errors & Omissions insurance. You need to pay your renewal fees. You are just not required to do anything that requires in-person attendance or doesn’t allow for social distancing.

Q: If I can find online education, do I need to stop working towards a license during the State of Emergency?

A: No. Feel free to keep working. We advise that you engage in social distancing, but if you can take online classes or online steps, feel free to proceed.

Q: Does this mean I can’t get a license while the State of Emergency is going on?

A: No. If you complete all requirements to get a license, the staff will issue one.

Q: I have a question you didn’t cover here. Who can I ask?

A: Feel free to reach out to the Commission’s staff; however, be advised that state government staffing levels have been reduced. Please be patient, but someone will get back to you.
