A regular meeting of the Kentucky Real Estate Commission was held at the Kentucky Realtors Summer Retreat in Owensboro, Kentucky. The meeting was called to order by the Commission's Chair, Lois Ann Disponett, at 1:09 PM CDT on Thursday, June 14, 2018. A quorum was present. Guests in attendance were welcomed.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

Ruth Anne Bower – KRI

A motion was made and seconded to approve the May 24, 2018 meeting minutes. The motion carried.

Education Report

Hannah Carlin presented the education report.

Core/Continuing Education Compliance: 12,677 licensees are currently required to complete either the Kentucky Core course or Continuing Education by December 31, 2018. As of June 5, 2018, 1,807 licensees have completed their education requirements for 2018, approximately 15%.

Post-Licensing Education for June 2018: 97 licensees have to complete the post-licensing education requirement in the month of June. As of June 5, 2018, 59 of those licensees have completed the requirement, approximately 61%.

Commissioner Billy Beckham made a motion for the approval of the continuing education course applications presented. The motion was seconded and the motion passed.

Licensing Report

Nick Van Over presented the licensing statistics for the 2018 January to May totals. This was for information only and no action was required by the Commission. 186 new total licenses were issued for the month of May. The total number of current licensees including both sales associates and brokers stands at 21,957.

Committee Report

Applicant Committee

The Commission decided the best procedure would be to establish screening criteria in regards to the review process for pending applications and background checks of applications containing misdemeanors and felonies. Director Corder commented that with the efforts of the Commission, since he came on board with the KREA the case backlog has been cut down to roughly four (4) pending applications from one hundred twenty-nine (129) cases. Commissioner Wiseman expressed the importance of professionalism and the concern she has that each application should be carefully reviewed in light of upholding professional standards. Commissioner Beckham made a motion to accept and create the applicant review committee to be made up of Commissioner Wiseman and Commissioner Waldrop as members. Commissioner Hayden seconded the motion which carried.

Complaint Committee

The Commission is working through complaints and coming up to speed.

Education Committee

The Commission is still in the process of establishing this committee to work on raising the bar on standards. The goal is to ensure that education has substance and is not just a time filler. The Committee is taking input from all across the state. A survey with specific questions will be sent out and Director Corder asked that feedback be submitted as it will be taken seriously.

A second committee is working on reviewing the broker core course, the core course, PLE licensing course that involves regulations, and the broker management course. The committee is going through these courses with the instructors and looking at ways of updating and modernizing them. The goal is to produce substantive learning outcomes and not just the memorization of facts.

Legal Report

In the matter of Wendell Drakeford's escrow account issue, Commissioner Hayden made a motion to accept the legal counsel's recommendation to advise Mr. Drakeford to close the account, by remitting the \$500 to Barlow Homes (now Commonwealth Designs) and to remit the remainder to the Recovery Fund so that if someone materializes in the future, there are funds upon which to make a claim. In addition, the Commission will offer an agreed order to Drakeford that dismisses all license law violations if he complies with this direction of the Commission. Commissioner Wiseman seconded the motion, and it carried.

In the matter of an associate appointment to close deceased broker's office, Commissioner Wiseman made a motion to approve the request. The motion was seconded and passed.

In the matter of Linda Blake's failure to re-affiliate, the Commission voted to move consideration of the matter to the next meeting. Commissioner Wiseman made a motion, Commissioner Hayden seconded it, and the motion carried.

In regards to the new advertising regulation draft, a motion was made by Commissioner Hayden to pass discussion to the next meeting. The motion was seconded and carried. New KREA general counsel, Heather Becker, would like some time to review and come up to speed before addressing.

Real Estate Authority Executive Director Comments

Director Corder thanked KYR for hosting the Kentucky Real Estate Commission meeting at the KYR Summer Retreat. He noted it was the first time in history to take place and thanked everyone for their involvement and attendance.

Director Corder also officially announced and welcomed Heather Becker to the Kentucky Real Estate Authority (KREA) as the new general counsel.

KREC Chair Comments

Chair Disponett reiterated appreciation for everyone attending and the value of feedback and participation. Introductions of KREC staff and Commissioners were made.

Public Comments

Concern was expressed for the act of licensees obtaining a broker's license in Indiana and then coming over to Kentucky and becoming licensed principle brokers with very little experience. It was requested that the KREC look into this. Director Corder commented that this was recently brought to his attention and that he is very concerned about the issue. Nick Van Over, KREC Licensing Coordinator shared that this came to their attention about three weeks ago and they are in the process of looking into it. A large part seems to be a matter of differing terminology and definitions of licensure status between the states of Indiana and Kentucky. Chair Disponett asked that this item be added to the agenda for the next meeting to pursue further.

Concern for the sizing of the office name in the advertising regulation was expressed. This was duly noted.

Unlicensed broker problem was brought to attention. The Commission stated that the KREC does not have much authority in this area according to statute.

Request for work on license recognition to move forward was made. The bulk of this issue rests with the other states and their requirements. The Commission advised that the issue will be taken under consideration and the Commission will look into it further.

Executive Session, Legal Matters, and Case Deliberations

No executive session was held this meeting.

Other Matters

Chair Disponett asked Director Corder to give a brief update and overview on things being worked on. Director Corder shared the following items in process of being worked through and under consideration: raising the CE requirements to twelve (12) hours from six (6), consisting of six (6) hours in legal education, looking at moving to a two (2) year renewal, creating a six (6) year limit for inactive status minus some needed exceptions, forms are back on the website and some statewide forms are being worked on, lastly, requiring background checks when licensees come out of inactive status.

Next Meeting

The next regular meeting of the Kentucky Real Estate Commission will be held Thursday, July 19, 2018 at 9:00 AM at the Public Protection Cabinet, 656 Chamberlin Avenue, Suite B, Frankfort, KY 40601.

Meeting Adjournment

A motion was made and the Commission voted unanimously to adjourn at 2:07 PM CDT.
